#### IPEG 2008 CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

You are invited to submit abstracts for oral, poster and video presentations to IPEG's 17<sup>th</sup> Annual Congress for Endosurgery in Children, June 13-15, 2008 at the Hilton in Cannes, France. This is a multi-discipline pediatric endosurgery congress, and abstracts of all pediatric endoscopic specialties are welcome. Authors may choose from the following categories: *Basic Science, Thorax, Gastrointestinal & Hepatobiliary, Robotics & Emerging Technology, Urology* and *Miscellaneous.* However, the Program Committee reserves the right to allocate the category of each accepted abstract in the final scientific program. The official language of the congress is English.

#### Deadline For Submission is November 30, 2007

Abstract submissions will be accepted online. Authors may indicate their preference for presentation format on the submission form, and the Program Committee will take your preference into consideration. However, the final decision will rest with the Program Committee. Video submissions must also mail their video to the IPEG Office along with their online submission. Videos should focus on new aspects concerning operations, techniques and tricks. Videos sent to the IPEG Office are for review only and will not be returned to the author. All abstracts must be original work that has not been published or presented prior to the 2008 IPEG Congress. All Abstracts must also be submitted in English.

All authors will be notified by email in February as to the status of their abstracts. Accepted abstracts will be published in the June issue of the IPEG official journal, *Laparoendoscopic & Advanced Surgical Techniques*. If a paper is selected for a long oral presentation, authors are required to submit a complete manuscript to the journal no later than April 25, 2008 or your abstract will be reassigned as a poster presentation.

IPEG Sponsors the **Best Basic Science Abstract** award in the amount of \$1,000 US dollars to be presented during the meeting. It is based on a blinded review and will be selected by the IPEG Program Committee. Award recipient must be present to receive the award.
